SITE SANTA FE LAUNCHES CONTEMPORARY ART IN CONTEXT
A NEW EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVE

Beginning Thursday, November 3, 2005 at 6 pm

Santa Fe, NM — SITE Santa Fe is pleased to present **Contemporary Art in Context**, a new educational program to ground the art of today in art history. The first course, comprises four lectures, will examine pivotal artists of the 1960s, and will meet this fall on Thursday evenings at 6 pm, beginning on November 3, and continuing on November 10, 17, and December 1. Future courses will address the most influential art of the 1970s, '80s, and '90s, as well as artists' media and techniques, and the relation of visual art to the performing and literary arts.

Ticket prices for the series are: \$36 for non-members; \$20 for students, seniors, and SITE Santa Fe members at Friend, Family, and STUDIO levels; **tickets prices for individual lectures** are: \$10 for non-members; \$5 for students, seniors, and SITE Santa Fe members at Friend, Family, and STUDIO levels. Contemporary Art in Context: The Sixties

The inaugural course in Contemporary Art in Context will investigate the seismic changes in the art world of the 1960s that continue to have profound effects in the art of our time. The birth of Minimalism, Pop, technological and performance art as we know it all took place in the 1960s. This course will examine works of art by some of the most influential and prescient artists of that decade. Presented by SITE's curatorial and educational staff, along with occasional guest lecturers, each one-hour session begins at 6 pm, and comprises a 40-minute slide lecture and a 20-minute question and answer period.
